









Step 4 - Accessing Google classroom




You should see all the classes that have been assigned. There is also an option to join a new class. Classroom codes should be given to students by their teacher.

Step 6 - Completing work




Some tasks may require you to make a word document or slideshow. You are able to access then via the 9 small dots at the top right hand side.

There is also a mail feature you can use to ask teachers for help if you get stuck.

Step 7 – Submitting work

Once you have completed your work you will need to submit it. You can add your work in and when submitted click 'Mark as Complete'.

You can also write a public and private message to the class and teacher.



Other Devices



On a tablet or smart phone you can access google classroom via the internet in a similar way to listed above or download the Google classroom app and login using the same details discussed in step 3.
