Ready to Learn (R2L) Equipment Requirements 2024/25

Dear Parents/Carers

Please find below information concerning **required equipment** for all students to be 'Ready to Learn' each day. Do take the time to read it thoroughly as there are changes to what we have required in the past. I have been communicating with parents and carers this academic year about the **importance of bringing correct equipment** and I'm also aware you will be purchasing items ready for the new academic year.

School Equipment

All students must have the following equipment every day for school to ensure they are ready to learn:

- Pencil case
- Two black pens
- Green pen
- 2 pencils
- Highlighter
- Ruler
- Compass & Protractor
- Scientific calculator (Casio fx-83GTCW-W)
- School bag

From September we will **monitor all students' uniform and equipment using weekly 'Smart Cards'** found in their student planners. If students do not have the correct equipment at any point in the school day, they will receive a written warning on their Smart Card, as they would if they did not have the correct uniform. **They will have until the following day to rectify the issue.**

RGS Stationery Shop

From September we will sell both full packs and individual items from our **RGS Stationery shop**. The shop will be open for business in both West and East receptions every school day.

You may of course wish to source items from high street or online retailers.

Purchasing In advance or on the day/during the year

We are delighted to be able to offer parents the option of purchasing full R2L equipment packs for collection at the start of the Autumn term. This can be done via ParentPay.

Full packs or individual items can also be bought via ParentPay throughout the year.
