Dear Parent/ Carer

Student-Led Academic Review: Thursday 13th February 2025

I hope this letter finds you well and am writing to inform you about our plans for parental feedback this year. The aim of our Student-Led Academic Review is to discuss academic potential and engagement across all subject areas and across the wider school. During the meeting, students will reflect on their own progress this year. The development of self-evaluation skills impacts greatly on a young person's ability to manage their learning effectively and is a skill that we believe is essential to develop in our students.

The feedback session will take the form of a 15-minute meeting between the Form Tutor, yourself and your child, during which your child will complete a 5-minute presentation focused on his/her academic progress. This will be followed by 5-minutes of staff feedback delivered by your child's Form Tutor, the person best placed to provide an overview of the school life of an individual student. Finally, there will be a discussion which will lead to holistic targets being created for your child to work on over the remainder of the year.

In the weeks prior to 13th February your child will spend time in tutorials, producing a self-reflection which will be presented to you on the day. At the appointment you will also be provided with a snapshot report and subject specific targets which will allow you to support your child's progress. If you wish to speak to a subject teacher regarding a specific issue, a request for contact can be made at the Review day.

The Student-Led Academic Review day will take place on Thursday 13th February 2025, and all Student-Led Academic Review appointments will be on that day between 8am and 6pm in your child's Form Tutor room. Appointments will be organised by students and their Form Tutor.

Students will not be required to attend school on that day, other than for the appointment. Independent work will be supplied by the subjects your child attends during that day, to support continued learning.

I will be in contact at the start of next term with a further update regarding appointments and siblings.

We look forward to welcoming you on the day and hope you have a restful holiday.
