GCSE, AS and A Levels 2021

This half term has been extremely challenging for students and staff. We have worked with a newly developed assessment system that has seen students complete many smaller in-class assessments rather than large exams over the last five weeks. In completing these assessments we have followed the regulations of the examination boards which administer our qualifications. The attitude of our students has been exemplary, there has been a positive, focussed atmosphere around the school and we wish them all the best in their results.

WJEC Results

WJEC are following a different process to the other examination boards with preliminary results being issued through the school. Any students who study a subject examined by WJEC will receive a preliminary results sheet by email on 22nd June. If you wish to discuss these results please contact the school through RGSenquiries@sch.im and a member of senior staff will contact you as soon as possible. An appeal can be requested at this point, related to the procedures followed by the school. Appeals forms can be requested by email from the above email address.

The initial appeals window will run from Wednesday 23rd June – Wednesday 7th July, a second appeal window will be open after the results day in August. Further information about the WJEC appeals process will be given if you request an appeal.

English Exam Boards, SQA and CIE

There will be no provisional results for subjects which follow AQA, Edexcel, OCR, Eduqas, SQA or CIE. Instead the exam boards will sample our evidence to check whether it is comparable to other schools before issuing results on August 10th (SQA, AS and A Level) and August 12th (GCSE and all CIE subjects) alongside the confirmed results from WJEC. The appeals process for English exam boards, SQA and CIE will run in August. There will be further communication regarding the logistics of these two days and the appeals process closer to the time.

Thank you for your support and positivity during this extremely complex process. We have completed the vast majority of assessments and teachers are working extremely hard to mark, moderate and evidence all the work completed by students. We hope that the next stage of the process, interacting with the Examination Boards, will be as positive as the assessment phase.
