Y7 Geography Fieldwork

Dear Parent/Carer

The Geography Department has organised field study visits for Year 7 students to take part in some outdoor learning. We will be undertaking a river study at Glen Mooar. The activities will include taking measurements of the river and drawing sketches to support the students' classroom topic of Rivers.

The dates and times of the visits are as follows:

Tues AM 11th June 7R and 7V (Ms Grace, Mr Sorby, Mr Hart, Mrs Dyer Mr Keenan, Mr Dewick)
Wed AM 12th June 7A and 7S (Ms Grace, Mr Sorby, Mr Hart, Mrs Dyer, Mr Skillan, Mr Dewick)
Thur AM 13th June 7B and 7C (Ms Grace, Mr Sorby, Mr Hart, Mrs Dyer, Mr Lillie, Mr Skillan)

On each day we will be leaving RGS at **9.30am** and returning by **1.45pm**, travelling by bus to Glen Mooar. As the visit includes lunchtime, all students will need to bring a **packed lunch and a drink**.

We will be working out of doors and part of the study will involve taking measurements in the river channel. **Suitable footwear for walking through the glen is essential**. It is also recommended that students have a pair of wellies, dress in old clothes and have a waterproof jacket with them if the weather is wet.

Students will be back in school for the afternoon session and must make sure that they have appropriate books with them. They do not need to wear uniform.

The Geography Team expect a high standard of behaviour at all times, and this is especially important when we are out on field work, as poor behaviour can put students at risk. Students who display inappropriate behaviour in lessons will not be allowed to take part in the field study.

Let's hope that the weather is kind, and we have three enjoyable sessions of field work!
