## **Year 7 Standalone Week**

I am delighted to give details of your child's activities for Standalone Week 2025, which will take place on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> July, Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2025. Standalone Week is designed to provide three enjoyable days for our school community outside of the normal structured lessons and is also a wonderful way to finish the school year together.

This year, individual year groups have devised their own programmes, so children in different year groups will not be offered the same activities. The Year 7 tutor team has put together a fantastic range of options, hopefully to suit all tastes and preferences (see below).

Each activity will take place in tutor groups, except for the swimming fun session, which is offered on a first come, first served basis at a cost of £2. This is payable via ParentPay or cash, and there are 60 spaces available. On Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July students will also be given a choice from six afternoon activities.

Most activities will be onsite, apart from swimming and Beach Buddies, which will be held at Ramsey beach and Ramsey swimming pool. We will walk the students to the swimming pool and Ramsey beach from school, returning in time for lunch. Lunchtime will be in the school canteen from 11.55am to 12.45pm for all Year 7 students.

Students should bring a water bottle each day and wear suitable footwear for outdoor activities. For the swimming session they will need swimwear and a towel. They should also bring extra snacks for breaktime.

Students should wear non-uniform on all three days. We will register in the West Hall at 8.45am each morning and will finish at the normal school time.

On Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July, Year 7 will take part in Northern Six Day. A separate letter will be sent to parents with further information about this day.

We will be using the existing medical information we have on file, so please inform us of any new medical issues or concerns.
