Northern 6 Day is a fantastic opportunity for students to try out a variety of sports led by qualified coaches and club representatives from across the north of the Island. Throughout the day your child will take part in sessions including Golf, Rugby, Handball, Netball, Hockey and Badminton.

Here's what you need to know for the day:

- Your child should arrive at school in their PE kit and go straight to the Sports Hall for registration at 8:45am
