Dear Parent/Carer

Year 7 Geography Fieldtrip

We are pleased to inform you that Year 7 students will be taking part in a Geography fieldtrip to Glen Mooar as part of their current work on rivers. This visit will support students in strengthening their understanding of how physical processes shape the local environment, helping them make meaningful connections between classroom learning and the Isle of Man's geography.

The trip will take place during the school day, over a 3-day period from Monday 13th July 2026 to Wednesday 15th July 2026, where 2 form groups will go out each day. Students will leave during morning registration and will return to school in time for lunch.

The cost of transport for the visit is £5, which covers the return bus journey. This should be paid via ParentPay. Students will also need to bring a packed lunch with them; though any students that receive free school meals will have a packed lunch provided by the canteen on the day.

As this is an outdoor fieldwork activity, students are expected to wear sensible footwear and appropriate clothing for walking on uneven ground. Please be aware that in some areas the ground may be wet and a students may get their feet wet during the activities. We, therefore, recommend that students come prepared with suitable footwear and, if possible, a spare pair of socks and shoes.

This fieldtrip provides an excellent opportunity for students to develop their geographical enquiry skills and to experience first-hand the physical processes they have been studying in class.
