Year 7 Arrangements

As we prepare to welcome our new Year 7 students, I would like to provide some information about arrangements for the first day of term on Thursday 3rd September 2026.

The school day begins at 8.45am, and we ask that students arrive in good time to join their form group before the start of the day. On arrival, all Year 7 students should **go directly to the tennis courts outside the West Building** where they will line up in their form groups. Members of staff will be on hand to guide and support students as they arrive.

Students will then attend their first Year 7 assembly in the West Hall where they will be officially welcomed to the school and given important information to help them settle into their new environment.

The morning will consist of:

- A Year 7 welcome assembly at 8.45am
- Period 1 and 2 with Form Tutors, providing an opportunity for students to get to know their tutor group, receive their timetable, lanyard, planner and smartcard, ask questions and learn about key school routines and expectations.

Following this, students will attend their normal timetabled lessons for the remainder of the day.

Students will have a PE lesson during the day and will therefore need to bring their Games kit.

To support students as they settle into secondary school, Year 7 students will have an early lunch during their first week. This will allow them additional time to become familiar with the dining arrangements and the school site before other year groups arrive for lunch.

We understand that starting secondary school is an exciting milestone and we are committed to ensuring that students feel welcomed, supported and confident from their very first day. Staff will be available throughout the day to help students navigate the school and answer any questions they may have.

We are very much looking forward to welcoming our new Year 7 students on Thursday 3rd September and beginning what we hope will be a happy and successful journey at RGS.
