Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award 2025-2026

Dear Parents/Carers

We hope this letter finds you well.

We would like to inform you that from September 2025 your son/daughter can commence their Bronze DofE Award within the Duke of Edinburgh Awards Scheme which we run at Ramsey Grammar School. The Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme is a longstanding and prestigious 3 level award (Bronze, Silver and Gold levels). These allow young adults to learn and develop new skills and knowledge as well as gaining experience of working outside their comfort zone, gaining confidence and making new friendships.

Payments can be made via ParentPay from September 2025. The cost for the Bronze Award is currently £30.50

This will cover the cost of registration, the official booklet, pin badge and certificate upon completion of the award. Upon completing the registration process you agree to the following:

Your information will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and will not be disclosed to any third parties outside the Department of Education Sport and Culture, other than where we are requested to disclose information under statutory obligation or are permitted by law. Your personal details will be used for administration and will be removed when no longer relevant.

We ask if you could enrol your son/daughter as soon as possible to allow us to plan for our busy expedition season and 2-day expedition that is required for the Bronze award, this will be later in the next academic year. Upon completion of the registration form your son/daughter (or the email that appears on the registration document) will receive an email which will contain a personal ID number and an initial password, allowing them to access the eDofE online portal. This is where they will log all their information for the relevant sections of the award, which will be explained and demonstrated to them in a DofE training session. The training sessions will be held weekly on a Monday, straight after school, when students will receive the training required to allow them to take part in the

expedition. The dates and plan for these training sessions will be published upon the students return to school after the summer break. The DoE staff team will be on hand to answer any questions and assist with issues around the other sections of the award. These are:

Expedition, Skill, Physical, Volunteering.
