Proposed History Department Visit to Leeds & Manchester – 11/12th July 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

The History department is planning to take a party of Year 10 students to the Imperial War Museum North in Manchester and the Thackray Medical Museum in Leeds on 11/12th July 2024. The trip will be a big help to students in their studies on Germany 1918 – 1945 and the History of Medicine c1848 – c1948.

The trip will involve:

Thursday 11th July 2024

Depart Douglas early morning for Liverpool via Seacat: **Departure at 07.15** Travel by coach to the Imperial War Museum North (IWMN) in Manchester Tour of the IMWN including:

- Big Picture Show
- Artefact handling

Travel to Leeds Premier Inn, Elland Road. Dinner at the Cardigan Fields Complex, Kirkstall, Leeds

Friday 12th July 2024

Breakfast at hotel Travel to Thackray Medical Museum, Leeds Travel by Coach to Liverpool Sea Terminal Opportunity to shop in Liverpool Depart Liverpool for Douglas via Seacat: **Arrival at 22.00**

The cost for the trip will be **£150.** This includes ferry, coach transport, B&B accommodation in Leeds and £20.00 to cover food and drink costs. Entry to the IWMN is free, but there is a small cost for the Artefact session. These costs are included in the trip price. Please note that students may need to bring extra money for food, etc.

There will be 40 places available on the trip. These can be secured by paying a deposit of £50 via **ParentPay.** The balance can be paid in instalments with payment in full by Friday 10th May 2024. Deadline for payment of the deposit is Wednesday 27th March 2024.

Acceptance and participation on the trip will be at the discretion of the History Department staff and subject to adherence to the School's Code of Conduct on behaviour. Any student who has shown, or does show, a persistent reluctance to adhere to it will not be accepted on, or may be removed from the trip at any time, with potential loss of payments.

Any pupil who drops out of, or is removed from, the trip will only have monies refunded when a suitable replacement is found. Students who have paid the full amount of trip money and cannot attend the trip due to illness **must** have a doctor's certificate to receive a refund.
