  - Katriona became a troubled teen, drinking and taking drugs. But she was bright girl and despite the angry exterior, she caught the attention of her English teacher who could see her potential.
- Unfortunately Katriona was really struggling and she ended up dropping out of school, became homeless, pregnant and destined for a troubled life.



Her English teacher didn't give up on her though. He arranged a bit of money for childcare and a place at school to finish her English and Maths exams. She had given up on herself, but he didn't give up on her. Katriona went on to do a degree in Psychology at Trinity College, Dublin. She also got a PhD and started teaching there. Now she is a loud voice for access to education and set up a scholarship for disadvantaged students in her English teachers name; Mr Pickering.
