I hope this letter finds you well and would like to extend good luck to the students sitting examinations and thank them for being such a fantastic year group. I write to inform you of the support on offer for Year 11 students in the run up to their GCSE examinations in May and June, and about the organisation of Record of Achievement Day.

Many subjects have finished the content of the course and are starting to revise in lessons, in preparation for examinations. We find that the earlier students start to prepare, the better the outcomes in their GCSEs, and attending extra revision sessions has a significant positive impact.

There is a vast array of support available for students at lunchtime and afterschool, and collated revision times are attached to this letter. Please discuss the options available with your child. A huge amount of time and effort has gone into developing resources for these revision sessions, and it would be extremely beneficial for students to attend as many revision sessions as possible in the run up to Easter.
