'Year 12' will embark on their Art and Design A level course through unbridled freedom, as they get to select their own personal theme to explore throughout the coming year and into Year 13. The students will explore a series of personally selected artists, styles techniques and media. Each student will build a portfolio of work journeying through their theme through researching, analysing, experimenting and designing a series of personal outcomes.

'Year 13' will conclude their course by building towards a fully realised outcome based on their original theme formed in Year 12. After all the preparatory work, in Year 12, the students will reach their journey's end by creating a final piece in their own chosen media. The students will complete their Art and Design A level course through the preparation and completion of a fifteen-hour practical exam. The exam carries 40% of the students' overall mark.
